The Credit Union Foundation of MD & DC offers tiered training reimbursement grants to Maryland and D.C.-based credit unions with up to \$150 million in assets.

Asset Range	Reimbursement %
≤ \$75 Million	75%
> \$75 Million to ≤ \$100 Million	50%
> \$100 Million ≤ \$150 Million	25%

The Credit Union Foundation of MD & DC helps improve people’s lives by supporting credit unions’ abilities to serve their members and communities. Training for credit union staff and volunteers is an important component in meeting that goal.

Qualifying credit unions may receive:

- Up to \$750 per year, per credit union to help defray training costs
- Approved tuition reimbursements will be paid upon receipt of attendance verification
- Applicants may apply for tuition reimbursement for on-line or in-person course offerings
- Funding for this program is limited
